

DISTRICT OFFICERS

DCM (District Committee Member): An experienced G.S.R. elected by other G.S.R.s to represent the groups of their district in area committee meetings and to coordinate service activities in the district. The link between the local Groups and the General Service Conference (the rest of AA) *Previously held by Jon M.*

Alternate DCM: The Alternate DCM should assist, participate, and share in the responsibilities of the DCM, as well as fill in at area and committee meetings that the DCM is unable to attend. The qualifications for an ADCM are the same as for a DCM. It is suggested that each Alternate accompany the DCM to as many Area meetings as possible in order to gain the experience needed to step in for the DCM when the need arises. *Previously held by Dave D.*

District Secretary: Records the minutes every month for the district meetings and prints and distributes all district mailings. *Previously held by Karen S.*

District Treasurer: Receives and allocates money contributed from the district 41 meetings, distributing as needed for district purposes. *Previously held by Bob S.*

Note: All four district officers must be signatories on the District bank account, per the D41 guidelines.

COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSONS

Treatment Facilities

Ensures that a regular meeting is brought into local treatment facilities and coordinates a chairperson and speakers for those meetings. Provides pamphlets and other literature from the District to district treatment facilities and institutions. *Previously held by R. Heuston*

Chips

Holds the district stockpile of sobriety medallions / chips and sells them to the groups. *Previously held by R. Heuston*

PI/CPC (Public Information / Cooperation with the Professional Community)

Interfaces between the district and the public, including Students, DUI Classes, Senior Citizens, Church Groups, Neighborhood Organizations, Parent Groups, Youth Groups, Legal Services, Medical Services and other professionals. Works with local A.A. members to inform professionals and the general public of what A.A. can and cannot do.
