If a GSR is unable to attend any of the required events, their Alternate GSR should. If a GSR has no desire to attend and participate, elect another GSR. (Refer to the AA Service Manual and Twelve Concepts for World Service)

Many thanks to all GSR's and interested members who have been involved in General Service at the district level. *Keep coming back!* District 41 still needs the participation of all the groups through their GSR's to help us move forward.
