Theme: Bridging the Gap - Service work with Treatment Facilities & Correctional Institutions Before AND After

1 Hour Panel Sessions: 3-4 speakers, 1 per district, 10-15 minutes each. The time remaining (15-30 minutes) to be open mic for Q&A.

Closing Session: Bridging the gap between AA's in TF/Corrections and in our districts/society at large - summary of panel information as well as fresh insight into service work as a whole.

Topics: No specific panel topics selected yet but general consensus is to have the first panelist speak on the general aspects of service related to either Treatment Facilities or Correctional Institutions (depending on the session), then each panelist will progress the level of commitment or opportunities for service.

Area Coordinators: We are awaiting response from the area coordinators for TF and Corrections; Potentially we would have them speak either as a single or double length panelist, or combined in the closing session.

Cost: District 17 has volunteered to cover initial cost of the Day of Sharing, to be repaid out of proceeds. Remaining proceeds, if any, to be split equally amongst the four districts involved. Lunch to be provided via pre-arranged potluck throughout all four districts (no cost).
